This chart shows our income from 2021. Revenue from outdoor programs were our greatest source of income at \$8,038.00. Our total income for 2021 was \$16,376.00.

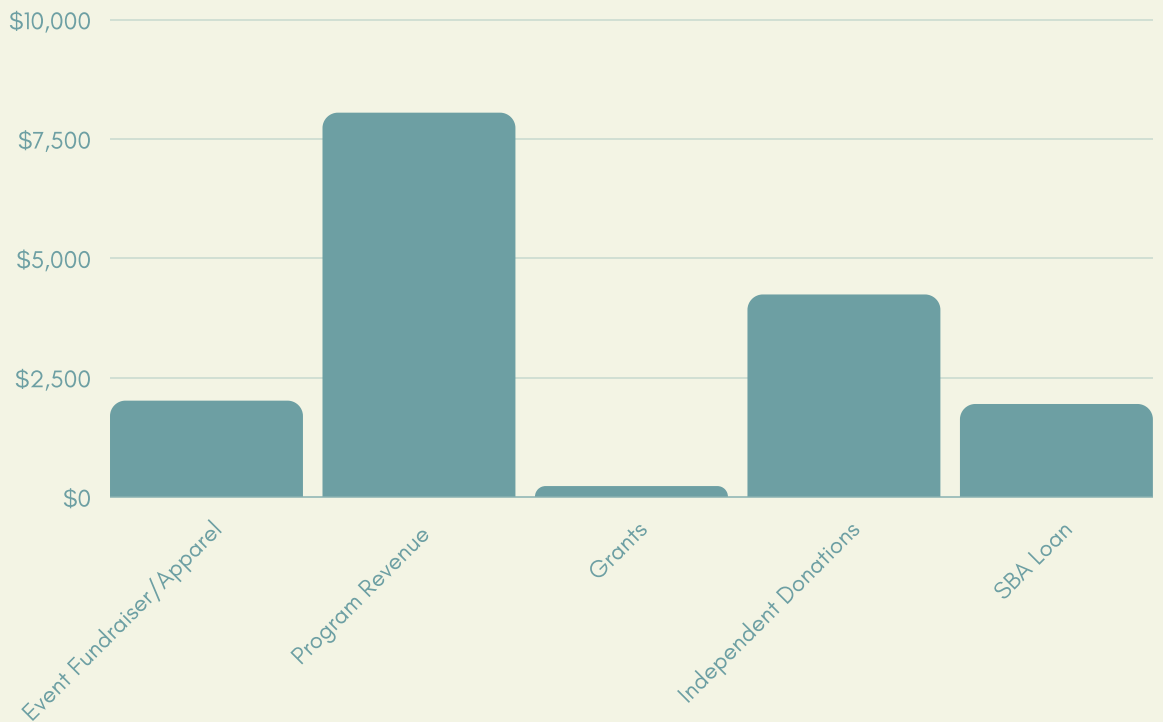
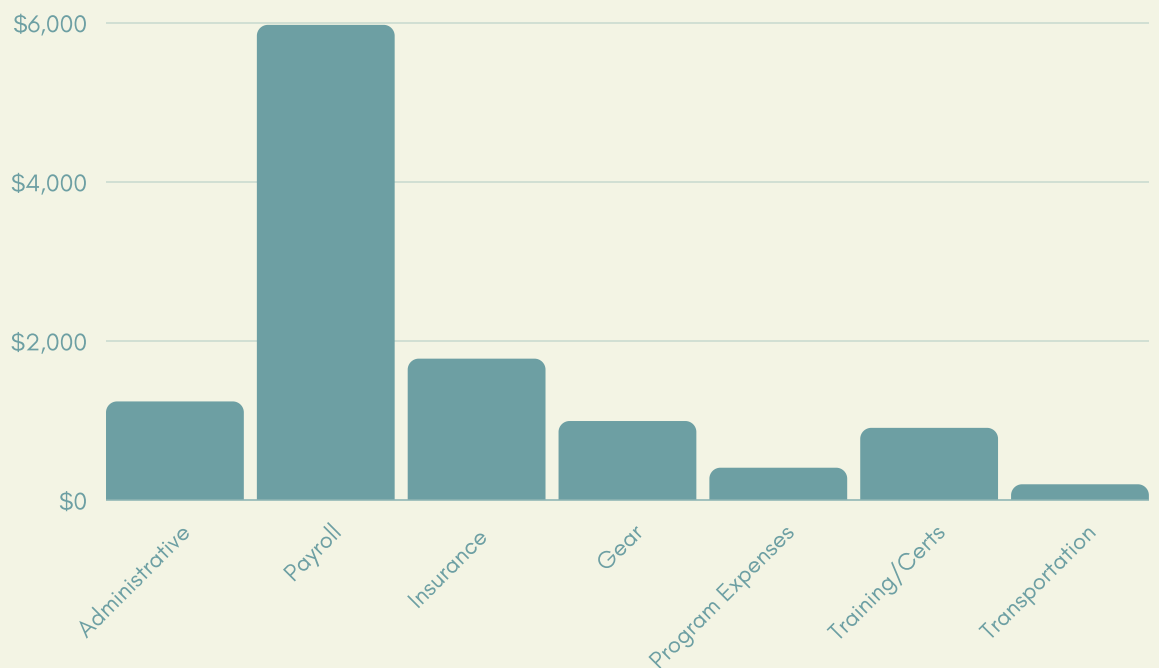

This chart highlights our expenses for 2021. Payroll was our greatest expense at \$5,965.96. Total expenses for 2021 equaled \$12,589.00.



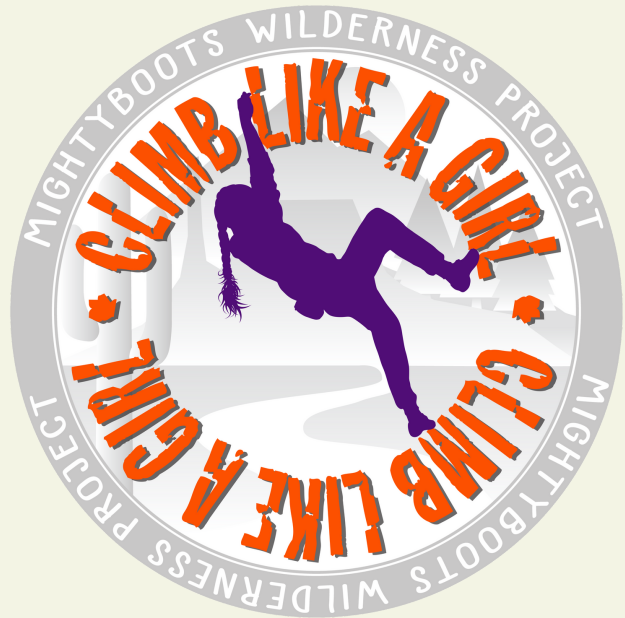
Our Outdoor Leadership Program

This is our featured program focused on experiential learning and social emotional development. Over the course of 8 trips that include hiking, outdoor rock climbing, and a 3 day, 2 night camping adventure, high school students will get their First Aid/CPR certification as well as a Mighty Boots Outdoor Leadership Program Certificate of Completion. These certifications can be put towards future college or career goals. Also, beginning in 2022, students will have the ability to earn 3 college credits through Maricopa Community Colleges over the course of this program.

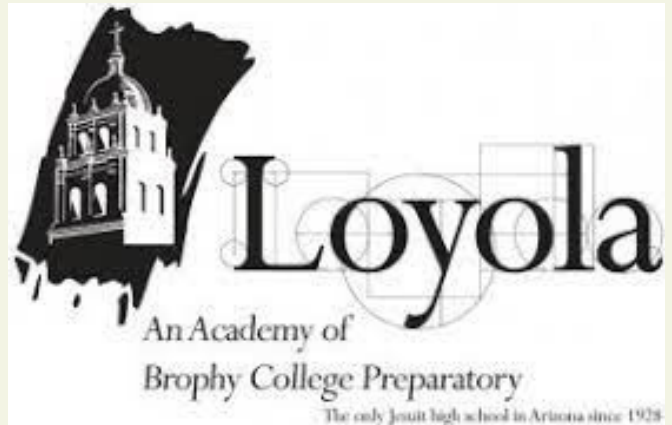
