Mighty Boots Wilderness Project had an incredibly successful 2022 and continued to make progress in bringing outdoor adventures to underserved communities in Phoenix and surrounding cities. Mighty Boots had 468 participants in programs including outdoor rock climbing, hiking, camping, and CPR certification courses. Also, this year, our Executive Director, Danny Taber, became an adjunct professor through Scottsdale Community College. He is teaching concurrently enrolled high school students in a 3 credit Outdoor Adventure Skills course.






FIGURE 2.




FIGURE 3.
